
Sunshine fills the rooms at the front during the day, giving a light airy feel. The deceptively long garden also benefits from the sun and is a perfect place to unwind after a long day.


Everything you could possibly need is on the doorstep – it's close to Solihull, Birmingham, national rail and motorway connections.


